Bones Of Fun:

Though tempting, dogs and cats should never be fed turkey or chicken. The bones in both of these are very brittle and splinter easily. They can cause serious internal damage including pancreatitis (manifesting as protracted vomiting and bloody diarrhea), peritonitis (puncturing of bowel, that leads to subsequent abdominal infection), and even intestinal obstruction. All of these can be life threatening and very costly to treat.
