

# Vaccinations:

## What do all the initials mean?

### FVRCP

Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis: Herpes virus that causes upper respiratory signs, ulcers on the eye, fever, and reproductive problems in unvaccinated females

Calici Virus: Respiratory virus causing upper respiratory signs, ulcers in the mouth, pneumonia, and occasionally arthritis.

Panleukopenia: Virus causing gastrointestinal upset including vomiting, diarrhea, severe dehydration, and death. Unborn kittens can develop problems with their nervous system.

### Rabies

**Rabies**: A deadly virus that attacks the nervous system. It typically involves three stages:

- 1) dummy stage
- 2) rage stage
- 3) death

### Feline Leukemia

**Feline Leukemia:** This virus weakens the immune system and can cause cancer.
